Along with this letter is a registration form for the upcoming series of basic disaster relief training (BDRT) events that we will host this summer and fall. BDRT, affectionately known as "yellow cap" training, is the basic training required for every area of involvement in disaster relief. In other words . . . do you want to help with serving food in a crisis? You've got to have this training! Want to be a disaster relief chaplain??? Yep! BDRT is for you. Chainsaw team . . . well . . . I think you get the picture.

We have six opportunities planned for you to participate in this four hour training and we are working on a seventh. I'll get word out if we are able to schedule it. We will be bringing the training to every region in the Dakotas, so you should be within a few hour drive of a training site.

Because each training event will be the same you only need to attend one. Lunch will be provided at each site, but we will not be able to provide childcare. Also, if you have not had yellow cap training in the Dakota in the last three years, you need to go through this training to be endorsed for work in Southern Baptist disaster relief.

The cost will be \$25, which will cover the cost of your disaster relief t-shirt, yellow cap, identification badge, and some of the other costs associated with our training. You can bring a check made out to the Dakota Baptist Convention to the training event you attend.

We need to have an idea of how many will attend each event, so please make copies of the attached registration form and get them to anyone in your church who is interested in attending one of the trainings.
